Something to remind:

The Past Perfect Tense

The past perfect verb tense is used to describe an event, happening, action, etc. that occurred **before** another portion of time, an event, happening, action, etc.

The past perfect tense describes **two** events and/or time-periods in the past that took place at different times.

The first action that occurred is expressed in the past perfect tense, while the following action is expressed in the simple past tense.

The tense is formed by placing:

had + the past participle of the verb

For example:

I had done... We had always eaten... It had not stopped...

She had been... Had you ever tried...? Had they lived...?

He hadn't finished... They had studied... It had been...
